


More about JTA....

Oracle understands that most of it's documentation is aging and that it still follows the same general pattern as the old Oracle 8i release. They realize that the documentation needs to be realigned and modernized. Oracle has targeted the Documentation and Certification of the upcoming12.x release to be redesigned based on Popularity and criticality of Tasks.

Initially Oracle Identified around 1400 tasks. The goal of the JTA task force was to discuss each of them and bring the total to less than 200. This short listed survey will be sent to over 300,000 Oracle Dba's around the globe to gather further feedback. Once that phase is completed the final decisions will be made for the oracle documentation and certification content.

Warm up – JTA Exercise

- Find a partner
- In fifteen minutes, create a high level description of your partner's job role
- Include:
 - What tasks they do in their role
 - Determine the criticality of each task they perform
 - Limit it to ten tasks
- At the bell, report out

Pre-survey to rate base pool of DBA tasks





Role Definition

- Define DBA role and specializations
- Create discrete task lists by specialization from the base pool of tasks plus additional input



Criticality Survey

- Produce a criticality survey for public response
- Use to adjust weighting and identify gaps








